

# Your Path to a New Career

We offer free career services to all local job seekers—including career navigation, job search support, workshops, and online skills training. Some job seekers may also qualify for one-on-one advising and funded training. This page explains what to expect and how eligibility works.

## What to Expect in 4 Steps

1

### Attend a Career Info Session

Learn about available services and how we can support your job search, virtually or in person.

2

### Meet with a Career Navigator

Have a one-on-one conversation to talk through your goals, experience, and interests. Your Navigator will help identify the support and opportunities that best fit your needs.

3

#### IF NEEDED

### Complete Your Career Pathway Application

If you're interested in more personalized, case-managed services, we'll gather key information together and complete an application with you. You may also take a brief math and English assessment to help align career options with your goals.

4

### Support Continues, No Matter What

If you're eligible for funded services, you'll work with a dedicated advisor who will guide you through next steps — helping you build new skills or land your next job. If you don't qualify, you'll still receive:

- Career navigation and job search assistance
- Career readiness workshops
- Online skills training
- Referrals to trusted community-based organizations and partners for additional support

## ABOUT FUNDING & ELIGIBILITY

Eligibility is reviewed after you meet with our team and helps ensure limited training funds are used where they can have the greatest impact. You may qualify if you:

- Authorized to work in the U.S.
- Live in Austin/Travis County (*some programs may also serve select Williamson and Hays County residents*)
- If male and within the required age range, registered with Selective Service
- Meet **at least one** additional eligibility requirement related to employment, income, or education

*Having a high school diploma or GED is strongly recommended. We can help connect you to GED support if needed.*
